**Action Requested at This Meeting:** Open Public Hearing and consider verbal and written testimony on the proposed update of the Kitsap County Stormwater Design Manual and Kitsap County Code Title 12 (Storm water Drainage).

On July 7, 2020, the Kitsap County Planning Commission is advertised to conduct a public hearing to solicit verbal and written testimony on the proposed 2<sup>nd</sup> draft revisions to the Kitsap County Stormwater Design Manual and amendments to the Kitsap County Code Title 12 (storm water drainage).
