Increase public attendance, diversity, and engagement at monthly meetings.	Ongoing	High	Increase outreach and communication. Use existing channels to notify communities of meetings and events (e.g. social media, trifold, postcards, etc.). Provide updates on identified "hot topics" to make meetings relevant to the community.
2. Facilitate community updates and ongoing discussion on Kitsap County's 2044 Comprehensive Plan, CAO, and PROS updates.	Ongoing	High	Regular updates and Q&A with Commissioner and County Leadership at meetings, committee reports, community input.
3. Facilitate community updates and ongoing discussion on current "hot button" topics.	Ongoing	High	Consider hosting Town Hall style meetings in certain geographies or a CKCC Open House to gather insights into hot topics. Field an online CK Community Survey as another way to capture input.
4. Facilitate regular public safety, Fire/EMS, Port of Silverdale, and public school district updates.	Ongoing	High	Regular updates from Central Kitsap Fire & Rescue, Kitsap County Sheriff's Office, Port of Silverdale, and CK School District.
5. Community Center activities and future facility.	Ongoing	High	Explore short- and longer-term strategies to create multigenerational activities and spaces. Look for ways to engage youth and seniors.
