Proviso Legislative Description:

Ferry traffic impedes the redevelopment of downtown Kingston. The project implements low cost enhancements that are forward compatible with the future realignment of SR 104 from Main Street to First Street for ferry traffic egress/ingress.

Task A. - First Street Design

Scope of Work:

Washington to Bannister. Re-aligns SR104 to move the inbound ferry traffic to the north couplet (1st Street), includes sidewalks where appropriate, ferry toll booth relocation, storm water, illumination, signals and signing.

Unfunded Elements: R/W Acquisition and Construction. Construction estimate - \$4 million

Holding Lot Feasibility and Preliminary Design:

- Identification of traveler amenities (restrooms, etc.);
- Operational review (how will the lot function);
- Off-site signage.
