## **Preservation efforts on SR 305 Agate Pass Bridge continue**

BAINBRIDGE ISLAND – Continuing preservation efforts on the State Route 305 Agate Pass Bridge, maintenance crews working for the Washington State Department of Transportation have scheduled three additional nights to perform expansion joint maintenance and to repair an asphalt bridge approach. The work will help create a smoother trip for drivers. The work also includes clearing the drainage system.

### **SR 305 Agate Pass Bridge will reduce to one-way alternating traffic:**

- 10 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 5, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 6
- 10 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 10, to 5 a.m. Monday, Sept. 11
- 10 p.m. Monday, Sept. 11, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, Sept. 12

This work is planned during night hours to minimize travel delays.

### **Looking forward**

Daytime lane closures will be required during annual bridge cleaning that typically occurs in February. The work requires daylight to use Under-Bridge Inspection Trucks and conducts a detailed inspection. WSDOT will announce the annual cleaning as it is scheduled.
