- Does online ballot access significantly improve the voting experience for voters with disabilities?
- How much value would an audible version of the Local Voters' Pamphlet create?
- What more can we do?

The Marvin Williams Vote Center opened this year. Daryl remarked on the potential impact this vote center will have on people in the community who cannot drive.

Mobile Vote Centers were removed at the start of the Covid-19 pandemic. We will look for ideas going forward on how to meet any needs that the Mobile Vote Centers provided.

Shawn mentioned that audio and lighting are extremely important when we're recording videos like L&A.

Shawn also asked if at Olympic College, would we prefer to set up in the Bremer Student Center or in the Military and Veterans Support Center? He said that may be able to reach a more targeted population at the Military and Veterans Support Center.

Steve mentioned that Thurston County opened something at their library that may operate something like a vote center. He will look into this further.
