OWNERSHIP


Harper Park is within the yellow boundary.

The park and estuary are located within a 640 acre watershed.

There are two miles of streams, of which about 0.6 miles have documented fish presence.

► Hatched area: WA DNR lands






access to water for kayaks, vehicle barrier along shoreline


Safety and parking
