DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: The Kitsap County Department of Community Development (the department) proposes an amendment to Kitsap County Code Title 17 'Zoning', Section 17.410.042, changing aggregate extraction to a conditional use permit in the Mineral Resource Overlay Zone.

Specifically, the amendment ensures:

- 1. Public participation during the permit review process.
- 2. Consideration of project-specific environmental impacts.

This chance is not retroactive to existing County-permitted aggregate extraction operations.

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The proposed action covers the geographical jurisdiction of unincorporated Kitsap County.
