DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of Proposal: 2018 Kitsap County Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan Update and Comprehensive Plan Amendment. The Comprehensive Plan amendment updates the discussion and strategies sections in Chapter 6 (Parks, Recreation, and Open Space) of the 2016 Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan. These amendments adopt certain content from the 2018 update of the Kitsap County Parks, Recreation, and Open Space Plan.
