#### **PURPOSE**

The Salish Behavioral Health Organization (SBHO) shall ensure periodic reviews of the triage facility consistent with contract requirements and state and federal regulations.

#### **PROCEDURE**

- 1. The SBHO shall conduct periodic reviews of SBHO contracted triage facilities located within the region that are currently certified by the State and licensed by the Department of Health (DOH).
- 2. The SBHO will conduct annual reviews of the triage facility and clinical charts. The review tool will be revised, as needed, to incorporate a more focused review, programmatic changes and/ or current compliance concerns.
- If the SBHO becomes aware that a facility is not in compliance with an applicable statue, rule and regulation, the SBHO will notify the proper authorities (certification/ licensing entity).

## **MONITORING**

- 1. This policy is monitored through:
  - Annual chart review of consumers receiving treatment at a triage facility
  - Grievance Tracking Reports
- 2. If a provider performs below expected standards during any of the reviews listed above a Corrective Action will be required for SBHO approval. Reference SBHO Corrective Action Plan Policy.
