3. Adoption of revised Recycling Service Level Ordinance	Planned	High	Update Recycling Service Level Ordinance with revised commodities to be collected (if any), greater flexibility in service levels/containers, uniform container specifications, etc.
4. Silverdale Recycling & Garbage Facility Design	Planned	High	Conduct public meeting in Central Kitsap on Facility Master Plan recommendations, procure design services; SWAC review and comment on design
5. Olympic View Facility Master Plan Review	Planned	High	Complete Facility Master Plan for Olympic View Transfer Station; SWAC review and comment on recommendations
6. Disaster Debris Management Plan	In Progress	High	Preliminary Draft has been presented to Dept. of Emergency Management, Kitsap Public Health District, and cities for review and comment; contractor assistance will be solicited to finalize and assist with Plan implementation
