SR 104 Holding Lanes - ATMS

Implement an Active Traffic Management System (ATMS) to manage eastbound WSF ferry traffic through Kingston on SR 104 (vicinity Lindvog Rd. to ferry toll booths) and improve SR 104 eastbound shoulder west of Lindvog Road. The project includes: the ATMS program; Intelligent Traffic Systems (ITS) operating system, detection, signal modification, and signage (on and off site); and improvements to the eastbound mainline shoulder (holding lane, approximately 400') improvements and associated improvements in the vicinity of the Lindvog/SR 104 intersection. Project is fully funded with federal funds using Toll Credits as Local Match.
