**General Obligation Bonds – \$42,000,000**

The Board of Directors of Bainbridge Island School District No. 303 approved Resolution 14-08-09 concerning a proposition to finance school renovations and improvements. If approved, this proposition will authorize the District to renovate and upgrade school buildings including roofs, heating systems, classroom equipment, safety and security systems; improve energy conservation; replace Wilkes Elementary School and complete other capital improvements to District facilities; to issue \$42,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years; and to levy additional property taxes annually to repay the bonds, as described in Resolution 14-08-09.
