The purpose of this Addendum is to answer the following questions for the above referenced RFP.

- Page 5, section 17 “Serial Numbers” – can we strike number 17?
 - Our toilets are not serialized and to do so we would have undue cost. We track by QR code if reporting is required by the Kitsap County.

That is Fine

- Page 6, section 32 “Background Checks” – what would trigger this requirement? What type of background check would be required?
 - USS completes background checks at time of hired and randomly throughout employment. We can confirm that our employees pass, but cannot supply individual results.

Says “may” be required. Probable not needed for this contract.

- Page 7, section 39 “Reference Checks” – this section states that 4 references are needed, but page 17 gives us 3 references. Do we need to add a 4th?

3 are fine.

- Page 15, Exhibit C “Cost Proposal Form” – can you kindly elaborate what combo, trailer unit, and service mean on this page? What is to be expected of our products and services? How many stalls for the trailer, what type of services, etc...

No specific configuration, just the ability to move a toilet as needed by the County.

- Page 20, Exhibit F section 5.1.2 – can we strike “newly manufactured” and replace with “like new”?

That is fine.

- Page 21, Exhibit F section 5.3 – can we strike “title to”?
 - This does not transfer to rental.

Agreed, not needed.

- Page 22, Exhibit F section 5.4 – can we add “by Contractor”?
 - Example: “The Contractor shall at its sole expense repair any damage caused by Contractor to the satisfaction of the County.

That is fine.

- Page 22, Exhibit F section 6 – can we add section 6.5 stating “6.5 Notwithstanding the foregoing, Contractor's indemnity and/or defense obligations shall not exceed direct damages within the Contractor's proportional extent of cause”?

That is fine.

- Page 26, Section 10.1 – can we strike this section?
 - This should not apply to rentals/services.

Agreed, that is fine.
