**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

Description of Proposal: **Kitsap Reclamation and Materials, Inc (KRMI) Mineral Resource Overlay, Site Specific Comprehensive Plan Amendment, permit 18-00490.** The proposal consists of an amendment to the Kitsap County Comprehensive Plan for creation of a 69-acre Mineral Resource (MR) overlay on two parcels of rural property located adjacent to the existing Kitsap Reclamation and Materials, Inc. Basalt outcroppings occur throughout the site and typically extends to depths of more than 1,000 feet below the ground surface. Approximately 1.5 to 2.5 million cubic yards of mineral resource is estimated on site. The KRMI basalt quarry is in the Gorst vicinity of Kitsap County, Washington.

Lead Agency: KITSAP COUNTY

Location of proposal, including street address, if any: The site is located in the Gorst vicinity, north of Sherman Height Road in Section 29, Township 24 North, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
